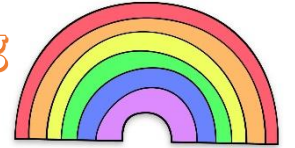

Do you think about all the people who grew the food and prepared it for sale?

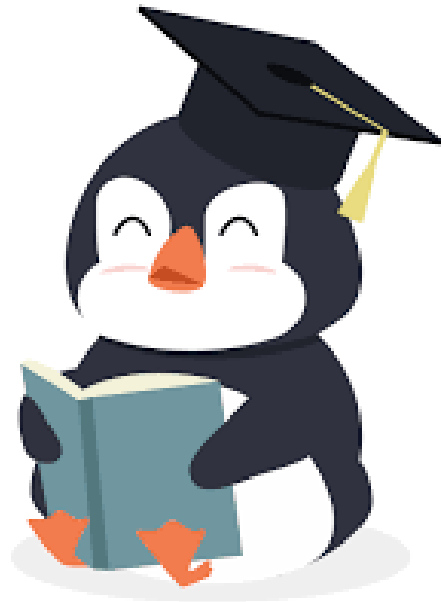
Perhaps you even want to say thank you to God for all the food on the table, silently in your head.

Dear God,

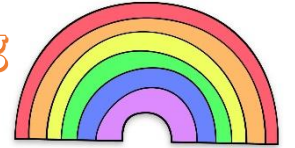
Thank you for all the amazing food that we have. Help us to

How do you feel about things changing? Is it exciting or frightening? How did they feel about changing classes? Was it good or bad?

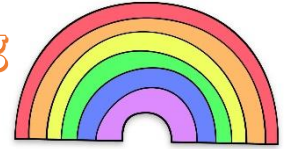
Dear God,

help us.

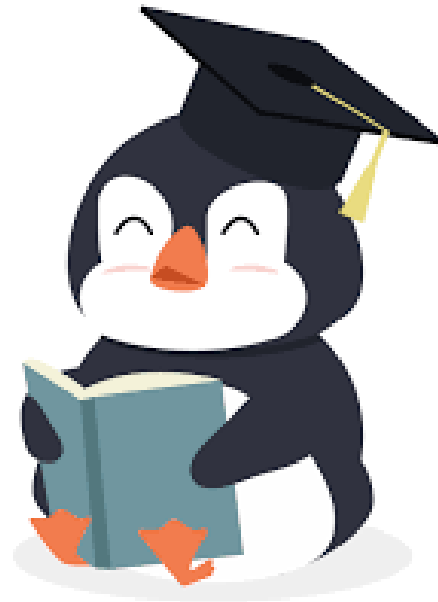
Help us to have faith in those things and not to give

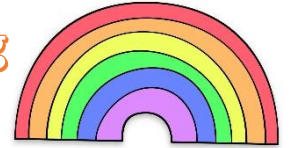

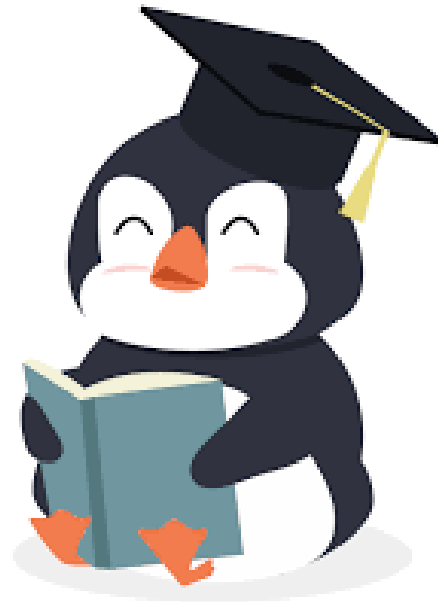

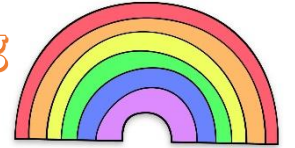
